• Earlu arrivals...

Early arrivals will not be checked in until 2:00pm.

Moving in...

Please do not move any belongings into cabin until after registration and completion of the head lice check.

Head lice check policy...

Upon arrival, all campers and staff will undergo a head check for lice. We recognize it can be a sensitive and potentially embarrassing matter which we will handle discreetly and with love. But, anyone who does not pass the check will need to be taken home by a parent even if they rode a church bus or travelled with someone else.
