Preparing Financially for Church Camp

Cost: \$375

A \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration to secure your student's place at camp and to lock in the current price break.

- If you register on or before April 16, 2017, you will pay \$299.00
- If you register on or before May 1, 2017, you will pay \$325.00
- If you register on or before June 1, 2017, you will pay \$350.00
- If you register AFTER July 1, you will pay \$375.00

We realize there are families that may not be able to cover the whole cost to send their student to camp. Financial may be available for families in those unique circumstances. If is the expectation of Crossroads that all families requesting financial assistance participate in fundraisers and other means of raising support for camp. By starting today, families can save/work/fundraise much of their camp expenses.

We work hard to keep the cost of camp low and also to be wise stewards of the funds we have available, but we realize it is a big financial commitment for many families. Here are a few ways to help cover your students cost of camp.

- ScripPro Gift Card Fundraiser: This is an on-going fundraiser that is a great way to gradually build up money for camp at no additional cost to you. Gift cards to popular stores, restaurants, gas stations, hotels, etc. are able to be purchased for face value with a percentage going towards your camp costs. You can purchase cards from Crossroads each Sunday morning and during office hours AND ONLINE AND WITH YOUR SMART PHONE. Please contact Jenny Bogue. - Payment Plans: It is possible, and encouraged, to setup a payment plan for camp. You can pay into your family camp weekly or monthly.
- Cardboard Boat Race: This is a fun way to raise money for camp. Each family builds a cardboard boat and asks for sponsors to support them as they race! Be looking for information on this event which usually takes place the first weekend of June.
